

MEASUREMENT AND REGISTRATION

Prior to the regatta, please ensure that you have all equipment required by the Class Rules and that those items meet Class minimum/maximums. You are required to have a 2011 IJ22CA membership decal on the starboard transom of your boat. New bow numbers will be applied by our Measurement Team, so please make sure that any existing bow numbers or sponsor decals are removed and that the area is clean. We request that at least two persons, one of whom has understanding of the measurement process and requirements, accompany your boat through the measurement process. Please separate your anchor, chain and rode from each other. As we will be weighing all rudders, you may wish to remove your tiller, as well.

MEASUREMENT STATION #1 - When you arrive at West End Park, turn right onto South Roadway and follow the signs to Measurement Station #1 (see attached map of West End). Sails will be dropped off here and delivered by our Team to the Sail Measurement Area, located under the Club House. *PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT ID TAGS WITH YOUR BOW NUMBER ARE ATTACHED TO EACH SAIL BAG.* These tags will be mailed to you before the regatta.

MEASUREMENT STATION #2 - After dropping off your sails, proceed to Station #2. Our Measurement Team (green vest) will inspect all “required equipment while racing” items, rudder, spinnaker pole, jib sheets and spinnaker sheets. We will provide you with a bag to help organize these items after they are checked and prior to the weighing of your boat. Rudders will also be weighed at this Station. After the rudder has been weighed please hang it in its normal position. Bow numbers will be applied by our Team.

MEASUREMENT STATION #3 – No cars are allowed in this area. A tractor and driver will tow your boat to your assigned parking place. Only boats with bow numbers will be allowed into this area. Step your mast and remove any items that are not permitted aboard for weighing. Remove forepeak cover and the two inspection covers below and ensure that these areas, as well as the bilge, are dry. Only the following are allowed on board for weighing:

- ❖ Hatch board
- ❖ Two (2) seats
- ❖ One (1) step and floor board
- ❖ Two (2) bin boards
- ❖ Forepeak cover
- ❖ Rudder, tiller with fittings and 1 tiller extension
- ❖ Rigged mast, boom and spinnaker pole
- ❖ Mainsail and jib cunninghams (1 each)
- ❖ Backstay adjuster and tackle
- ❖ Main traveler control lines and mainsheet
- ❖ Jib sheets, two jib sheet blocks and twing lines
- ❖ Spinnaker sheets and downhaul
- ❖ One (1) compass and other permitted, permanently installed, optional equipment

MEASUREMENT STATION #4 – After stepping the mast and removing any equipment not permitted aboard, you are ready for weighing. A member of our Traffic Team (orange vests) will direct you to the North hoist for weighing (Station #4) and then back to your assigned parking place. If your boat's weight is less than the Class minimum, corrector weights will be available for your installation.

MEASUREMENT STATION #5 - Once your boat measurement form has been completed you may pick up your sails under the Club House (Station #5). At this point you may proceed to the Registration Desk, located in the SYC Grill on the 1st floor, northwest corner of the Club House.

REGISTRATION – Please be prepared to present the following at the Registration Desk:

- ❖ Completed Boat Measurement check list
- ❖ Valid Class Measurement Certificate
- ❖ Proof of 3rd party liability insurance
- ❖ National J/22 Class Membership Card
- ❖ Proof of National Sailing Authority membership for all crew

Your sail measurement check list will be delivered to the Registration Desk by the Sail Measurement Team.

- Your registration will not be complete until all fees have been paid, crew members have been weighed and you have attached the event bow sticker to your boat.
- If you arrive at a time other than during normal registration hours, the boat may be parked in the parking area by Station 2.

PURCHASES AT SYC – Southern Yacht Club does not accept cash for purchases of food and beverages. You must obtain a guest card from the Receptionist located on the 1st floor. For those who are members of Clubs with reciprocal privileges, you may make charges back to your Club. Please be prepared to show your membership card to the Receptionist to obtain a guest card. For all others your guest card charges will be billed to your Visa or MasterCard.
